SSAAP-Sierra Leone Agreement: between SSAAP and School Sponsorship Beneficiaries

SSAAP-Sierra Leone School Sponsorship Beneficiaries should respect the following:

- SSAAP has a strict Nonviolence Policy. We do not tolerate violence within the communities we work with. We do not live with violence. We do not work with violence.
- SSAAP does not believe that violence and development exist simultaneously together.
- Violence must be eradicated from the schools in order to make them institutions of true learning rather than fear-based centers.
- If the school receiving a sponsorship from SSAAP is engaged in flogging, beating, slapping, punching, kicking, or humiliating (emotional/psychological abuse) pupils then the SSAAP School Sponsorship will be terminated.
- Any school receiving a SSAAP-School Sponsorship must refrain from practicing violence within the school. Shouting insults, physical abuse, flogging, humiliation of the pupils for wrong answers or for coming late to class, or violence towards the students for any other reason is not acceptable.
- The headmaster(s), principal(s), teacher(s) are all expected to abide by the Terms stated in this Agreement. If it is discovered that a SSAAP-Sponsorship School Beneficiary has participated in violence within the school, the sponsorship will be terminated and the school will be expected to refund the sponsorship to SSAAP in full.
